Death of Girl's Grandmother Gives Hoping Preacher's Soulmate \$40,000

HEMPSTEAD, L. I., July 26.—The twelve-year struggle for existence by the Rev. Jerre Knud Cooke and Florita Whaley, who defied social conventions and eloped in 1907, has ended. It was learned Thursday, that the death of Mrs. Katharine Whaley, the girl's grandmother, which releases a \$40,000 fund left in trust for her by her father.

Cooke and Miss Whaley were the most famous "soul mates" in the country until the rector's wife obtained a divorce and he married Miss Whaley. Unfrocked because of the elopement Cooke sought employment as a sign painter and the couple drifted westward to San Francisco, trying to bury themselves and avoid publicity.

They now have two children.
