ALL CARPENTERS KEPT BUSY ON NEW HOMES; PENDLETON TURNS TO REPAIRING OF OLD

With every available carpenter in
the city employed on homes now near
in completion, Pendleton is about to
see another few weeks of lethargy in
new building operations. Probably a
score of new homes will be completed
during the coming month and equally
that number of old homes are now be-
ing remodeled in preparation for fami-
lies who have decided that building is
out of the question.

The north side of the city is team-
ink with building activity of both
kinds and is doing its share to assim-
ilate the growth in population which
Pendleton has experienced. In spite of
increased costs, the city has seen an
unprecedented summer of building
and the coming of fall will see most of
the summer projects completed.

Millinery rooms are being decorated

ers. Only a small amount of work
will be done in the millinery but the

varnished and decorated. The work
has just begun in both these places.
