woman and child who wants to pick prunes is busy this week assisting in the harvest of this bumper crop, which is not alone bumper in quantity and quality, but also in price. \$100 per ton or better will be realized by the

growers. The third cutting of alfalfa will be started about next Monday and where the land has been well irrigated an average crop will be harvested despite the extremely dry season. No further sales of alfalfa have been reported this week but those who are holding for \$29 or better per ton are not worrying as from indications this price or more will be realized.
