### GUARANTEE TO FILL ARMISTICE TERMS TO BE FORCED IN DECREE

PARIS, Oct. 31.—The supreme council has decided to force Germany to sign a protocol guaranteeing she will execute the terms of the armistice to be attached to the original treaty as soon as it can be executed. The council also asked interallied naval experts to prepare a plan by which Germany reimburse the allies for the sinking of the interned German fleet at Scapa Flow.

The final reply to Bulgarian counter proposals will be submitted Saturday.

The council yesterday received official information from allied military and financial authorities that Germany violated several clauses of the armistice. The penalties to be exacted have not been announced.
