FIRING CEASES BEFORE RIGA WHEN AMERICAN DOCTOR CROSSES LINE

and night caring for the hundreds of soldiers wounded in recent severe fighting in front of the city.

The only medical and surgical supplies in the city are those brought by the Americans and these have been distributed to local hospitals where the largest number of wounded can be cared for.

Although shells have been dropping within a few blocks of the hospitals for days, and the city has been in imminent danger of capture, not a member of the American forces has hinted at leaving the city.

Lieutenant - Colonel Edward H. Ryan, of Scranton, Pa., is here, from Berlin to take charge of the situation. He entered the city through the German lines under a flag of truce. All firing by both sides stopped as he came across the bridge, the first man to enter the city from the land side since the siege of the city by the enemy.

This last experience of Ryan is only one of many thrilling episodes in which he has participated during the past ten years. Before the war, he was physician to the American embassy in Mexico City, and during a trip through that country was captured by bandits. His disappearance precipitated an international crisis. But in two weeks he escaped and turned up safe and sound.

He came to the Balkans early in 1915 and had charge of a unit in Serbia. When the Austro-German forces invaded the Balkans he served as mayor of Belgrade for a short time; then was imprisoned by the Germans for eight weeks. During his stay in German hands he continued his medical work with Serbian wounded and upon his release set out to reorganize the Red Cross Commission in the Balkans.
