Oats showed slight gains, the prices today being \$53 for two grades and \$55.50 for the first grade. Barley quotations were unchanged at \$66.50, \$68 and \$68.50, with mill feed also steady at \$40.50.

NATION RAISES FUND TO BEAT U. S. AT OLYMPICS

NEW YORK, Dec. 2.—England will spare "not a shilling" to win premier honors in the 1920 Olympic game.

Such are the reports that are drifting from the British Isles where steps are already being taken to get a team ready for the Antwerp games.

It is said that A. N. S. Jackson, former president of the Oxford University athletic club, and who served with distinction as a battalion commander of the Royal Rifles in the war, is the prime mover in the preparations.

He recently recommended the raising of a \$500,000 fund to train the British team. He outlined plans for the erection of a training camp, the employment of competent instructors and trainers and accommodations that would encourage the best athletic talent of the kingdom to try for places on the team.

France is figuring on assembling valuable to pawn for an olympic fund. Sweden has already subscribed several thousand dollars for the purpose and in many of the smaller nation organizations have been named to handle the teams. In America, however, nothing has been done to get the team ready that every nation has resolved to beat.

From Germany walls have arisen over the decision to bar the "kultured" athletes from the 1920 games. The Germans have not only been denied admission for the coming games, but if France has her way about it, they will never be allowed to enter the international competitions.

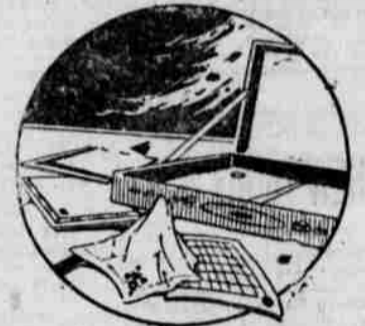
