MODEL IRRIGATION FARM AT EXHIBIT

MELBOURNE, Dec. 12.—The most unusual exhibit ever offered in an agricultural show will be the 50 acre model irrigation farm to be featured at the Royal Agricultural Society's show soon.

The whole design planned by R. W. Harvie, a member of the water commission, will be put into execution by government officers. The site for the farm has already been chosen, and upon it will be shown the methods of watering crops and trees and the practice generally adopted in irrigation districts.

Land has been subdivided, channelled and graded in a manner suitable for horticulture and mixed farming, embracing dairying, lucerne-growing, pig and poultry raising, and the production of vegetables and fruits. Water will be measured by a new registering weirsometer. Special buildings will also be constructed upon the site.
