Cranberries Are Selling
At 25 Cents a Quart.

Cranberries are retelling in local markets at 25 cents a quart. Another fruit seen in local markets is the Japanese orange. The oranges are 45 cents a dozen, and are shipped here from Japan.

Butter Retalls For
80 Cents a Pound.

The retail price of butter remains at 80 cents and 15.55, according to prices quoted by Pendleton grocers.

Variety of Vegetables
Seen in Markets.

Despite the cold weather a good variety of vegetables appear in Pendleton markets. Brussels sprouts retail for 30 cents a pound and sweet potatoes at 10 cents a pound. Head lettuce is 15 cents a head while hot-house lettuce is 50 cents a pound. Cauliflower retails for from 35 to 50 cents a pound. French artichokes are 20 cents each. Celery is 25 cents a head.

Manchurian Walnuts
Cheaper Than Other Kind.

Manchurian walnuts are retelling in Pendleton markets at three pounds for \$1. This variety is cheaper than the English walnut. The Manchurian nuts are of the new crop.

Hogs and Lambs Firmer
Cattle Are Plentiful.

There was a rather fair run of livestock in all lines except sheep at North Portland for the week's opening. The Monday market started with hogs firmer and higher, cattle showing a mixed tone and lambs firmer.

Killers were rather eager bidders at the opening of the week's trade and good stuff brought extreme figures readily.
