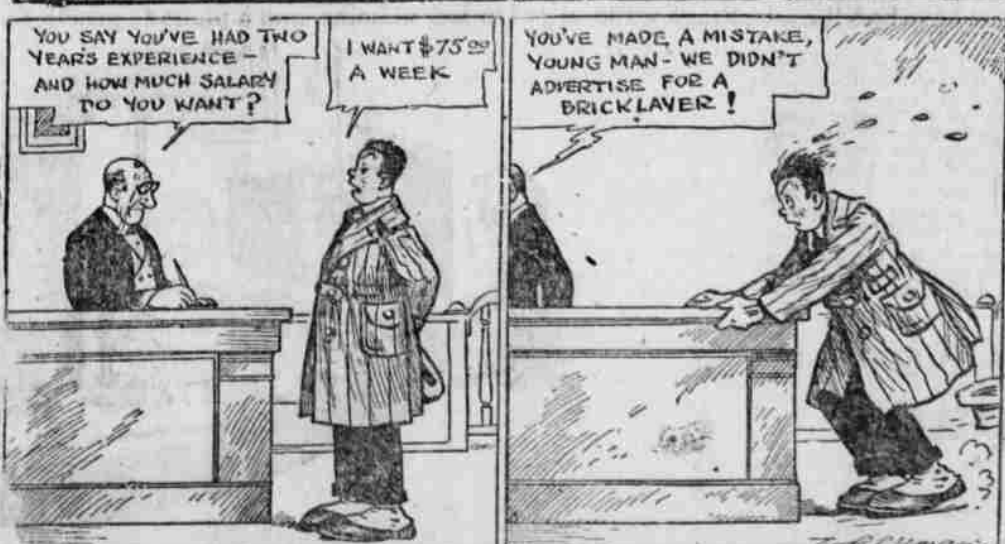

NOTICE OF STREET IMPROVEMENT

Notice is hereby given that at a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pendleton, held on January 10, 1920, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the City Surveyor of the City of Pendleton did on the 11th day of December, 1919, under direction and by requirement of the Common Council, file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Pendleton, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of the following named street in said city:

Matlock street from the north line of Bailey street to the north line of Bailey street, together with the estimate of the cost of said work and the proportion of the cost of said work to be charged against each lot, part of lot and parcel of land to be benefited by such improvement, and

WHEREAS, the Council has examined such plans and specifications and estimates and found the same satisfactory and the estimates thereof to be in accordance with the probable cost of such work, and

WHEREAS, the property recommended by the City Surveyor to be included within the boundaries of the district benefited is in the judgment of the Common Council properly to be included within such improvement District and no property is excluded therefrom which should properly be included therein; and

WHEREAS, the improvement of the hereinabove described portions of Matlock street, with Gravel Bitulithic pavement is at this time necessary, therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Pendleton that it is expedient to improve said Matlock street by paving the same with Gravel Bitulithic pavement; such pavement to be constructed and the surface thereof to be finished upon the established grade of said street and the street to have curbs and gutters and all other things in accordance with and as shown in the plans and specifications for the improvement of said portions of Matlock street, prepared by E. B. Hayes, City Surveyor, filed with the Recorder of said city on the 11th day of December, 1919, which plans and specifications are hereby adopted and approved and be it further

RESOLVED, that the engineer's estimate of the probable total cost of such improvement, which said City Engineer's estimate was made and prepared by E. B. Hayes, City Surveyor of said city, in the sum of \$2559.65, and was recorded by the Recorder of said city on the 17th day of December, 1919, is hereby included and referred to particularly; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the plans and specifications and estimates for such improvement as prepared by the City Surveyor and filed with the Recorder of the City of Pendleton on the 11th day of December, 1919, be and they are hereby adopted and approved and be it further

RESOLVED, that the cost of making such improvement shall be a charge and lien upon all lots, parts of lots and parcels of land to be benefited by such improvement, and the owners of such lots, parts of lots and parcels of land and so specially benefited by such improvement shall be liable for the payment of the cost thereof, and be it further

RESOLVED, that an Assessment District is hereby created to be known as "Assessment District No. 72," embracing the property to be benefited by such improvements, which said lots, parts of lots and parcels of land lying and being within the district bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Description of Assessment District No. 72.

Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot 6, Block 18, House's Addition to Pendleton, thence north 510 feet and parallel with the west line of said block street, thence east 20 feet and parallel with the north line of said block street, thence south 310 feet and parallel with the east line of said block street, thence west 200 feet to the point of beginning.

And be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution together with the notice that the surveyor's estimate of the proportion of the cost of said work to be charged against each lot, part of lot and parcel of land in the East Oregonian newspaper is hereby designated by the Common Council for the publication thereof.
