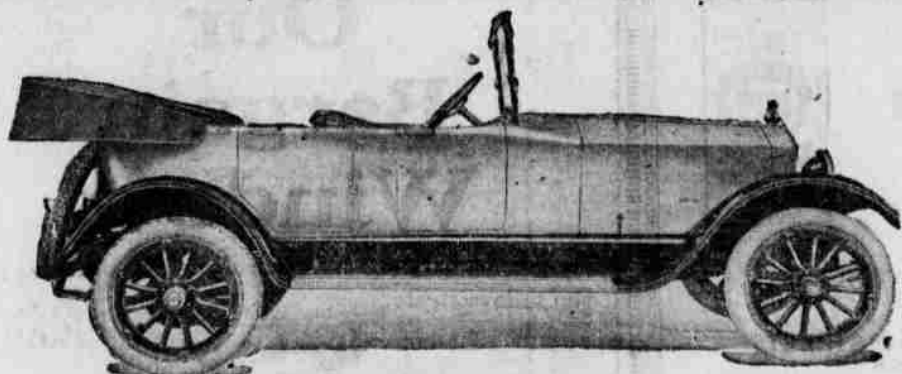

WILDER ACCUSES WITNESS

(Continued from Page 7.)

is going to die for it." With those words, Wilder aimed and fired the fatal shot at McNeece, Jones testified.

Jones Nervous Witness. Jones as a witness was exceedingly nervous and appeared unwilling to testify directly. He told that after Wilder had fired the shot, the latter returned to his house while Jones went at once to Estoup's place. Later in the afternoon he and Estoup, his brother-in-law, went to Wilder's where Wilder told Estoup that "Bert committed suicide." Jones admitted that he did not dispute Wilder's story and that he had no intention of divulging the fact that not suicide but murder had been committed.

The consumption of beer, iron and wine, vanilla extracts and moonshine liquor as beverages was brought into the trial yesterday afternoon and Jones admitted that all three had been drinking to some extent. He declared that he believed Wilder had imbibed more freely than either himself or McNeece. They were all good friends, however, he said, and he could not understand Wilder's motive for the shooting.

Evades Coroner. On the day following the shooting Jones met Wilder in Freewater where the latter paid the former \$50 for plowing. Jones took the freight train and came to Pendleton where he told of the shooting to an uncle, Sherman Jones. He admitted, upon questioning by Wilder's attorney, that he expected his uncle not to tell the story to anyone.

The coroner's inquest was held while Jones was in Pendleton and his testimony was missing. He admitted that he had no intention of telling his secret until called upon to do so and said he never thought that his presence might be necessary at the inquest.
