NEWS OF THE COUNTY OFFICES AND OFFICERS

Fee-Endecott Suit Dismissed.

The suit filed by James A. and Rose M. Fee recently against John Endecott and Anna E. Endecott, the Wells-Dickey Trust Co., and O. M. Corwin, was ordered dismissed in circuit court today. The action involved the sale of lands valued at \$21,000.

Jury Term Completed.

The circuit court jury was adjourned last night following its verdict in the Wilder case until early in February, there being no more jury cases to come before the court in the immediate future.

Van Petten Will Filed.

The will of the late N. V. Van Petten, who died in Portland in December, was filed with the county clerk today, together with a petition for its admission to probate. Mrs. Grace M. Cosper, daughter of the deceased, is the petitioner and is nominated in the will as executrix. The estate left by Mr. Van Petten, according to the estimate of the petitioner, was worth \$65,000. This is left entirely to the widow, with the exception of \$100 left to a son, Edward C. Van Petten, of Ontario, Ore. At the death of Mrs. Van Petten it is to go to Mrs. Cosper. The will is one of the shortest documents of its kind ever filed with the county clerk, containing but two provisions, and was made at Ponca City, Okla., April 15, 1910.

School Libraries Being Augmented.

Books which were recently received and catalogued by the county superintendent are now being packed and shipped to the various libraries in all the districts of the county. Superintendent W. W. Green says that any representative of a school district who is in the city in the coming few days may call for the books for his district if he desires.

Sending Out Thrift Cards.

The county school superintendent's office is now sending out to every school child in the county a thrift card upon which reports will be made of the purchases of thrift and war savings stamps during the year. The county which makes the best showing during the year will receive a prize.

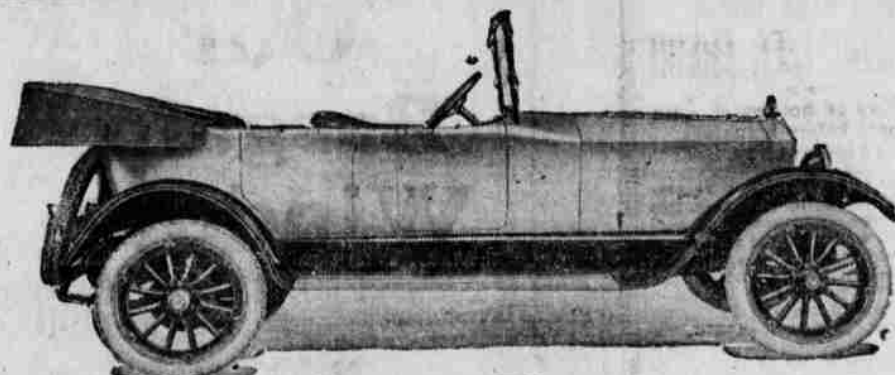

ASK BANKERS TO TURN COIN TO FIGHT H. C. L.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 23.—Big Bankers, meeting in Chicago, will have an opportunity to help the country free itself of the high cost of living problems, government officials today declared. By establishing an interest rate on deposits which will be uniform throughout the country and remain unchanged save in grave emergency, the bankers could effectively stop wildcat speculation and extravagance, officials said and pointed out that this would divert money to legitimate and normal industrial enterprise and stimulate production, bringing lower prices for all commodities. The result would be felt within 30 days, officials declared.

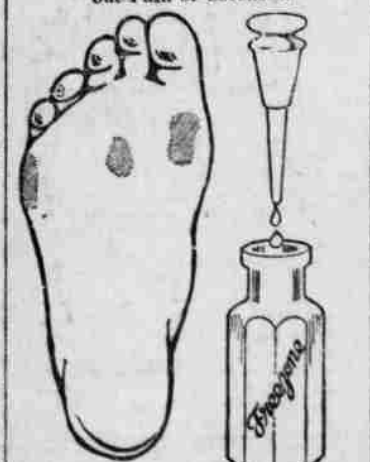
