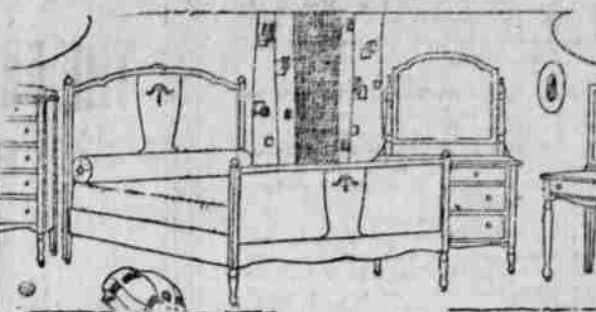

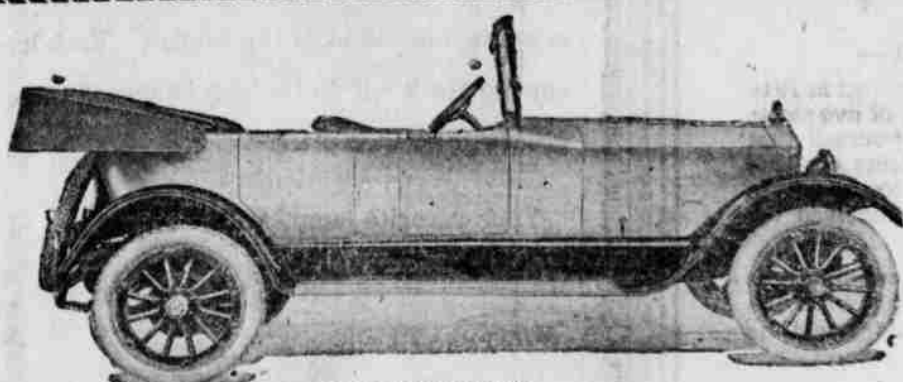

TIME FOR INVENTORIES ON LIQUOR EXTENDED

WASHINGTON, Jan. 27.—Internal Revenue Commissioner Rapier today extended until February 10 the time for filing inventories by persons possessing liquor and other fluids containing one half of one per cent or more of alcohol for beverage purposes. Today was to have been the last day for filing returns. The Volstead enforcement act stipulating that such returns must be filed within 10 days comes effective after constitutional prohibition becomes effective.

POLICEMAN FELLED BY BULLET FROM PISTOL

PORTLAND, Jan. 27.—Patrolman Ernest Grenfell, 23, brother of Fire Marshall Grenfell was shot just below the heart by a revolver in the hand of his friend, Jay Green, 22, in the former's room in the Collins hotel, Fourth and Clay streets, at 3:15 Sunday afternoon. In what is thought by the police to be another instance of an "unloaded revolver," Grenfell was taken to St. Vincent's hospital where physicians were making a desperate effort today to save his life. Reports from the hospital stated that he was suffering from an internal hemorrhage.

Grenfell, who is a member of the flying squad under Captain Harms of the second night relief was dressing to go to work when the accident happened. He and Green, an employee of the Columbia Optical company now living at Union and Tillamook streets, were discussing the revolver, which Grenfell passed over to Green for inspection.

Thought Gun Unloaded.
"I saw him remove the shells once," Green said. "The gun had passed back from one to the other several times. We had both been trying it and snapping the trigger. I did not see him replace the shells. Thinking the gun was still unloaded, I pulled the trigger and it went off. He fell to the floor."

Floyd Gaines, a fireman with engine company 4, 374 Fourth street, was sitting on the bed in the room when the shooting occurred.

"I saw both of them looking at the gun," said Gaines. "I don't know which one had it when the shot was fired. I wasn't looking and when I heard the discharge and jumped up, the gun was lying on the floor and Grenfell had fallen to the floor. We got him to the bed and I phoned for an ambulance at once."

Grenfell and Green had attended a theater earlier in the afternoon. They have been friends for many years, according to Green.

Says Shooting Accident.
Grenfell was in the room after shooting while waiting for the arrest

of the ambulance. In a statement to the inspectors he said the shooting was accidental.
