WOE BE TO RADICAL AGITATOR IN IDAHO: NET IS STRETCHED

BOISE, Idaho, Jan. 29.—Woe be to the radical agitator who sets foot in Idaho.

He will face an administration determined to "rid the state of this undesirable element," and equipped with possibly the most effective law enforcement agency to be found in any state—the Idaho state constabulary.

One man—Robert O. Jones, secretary of state and state commissioner of law enforcement—holds within his hands the power to make a policeman of every citizen in Idaho and can force every sheriff, police chief, mayor, prosecuting attorney or other officer to do his bidding, and to leave his own county or city and go to any part of the state to act for the constabulary.

This power to mobilize the state's entire strength at any place in case of an emergency is pointed to by proponents of the law as one of its chief virtues.

Idaho is like a nation with an unlimited draft law and a commander-in-chief empowered to exercise the draft at a moment's notice in putting down any type of disorder.

But Robert O. Jones, thus far, has not abused his power, according to those who opposed the law in its making.

"Administration of the constabulary has been all right so far," P. H. Park, president of the State Federation of Labor, told the correspondent. Labor vigorously opposed the act creating the constabulary, although, according to Park, it was "without friends in the legislature."

The constabulary has been functioning since May, 1919.

MRS. WILSON RETAINS COMPOSURE AT TRIAL

MARYSVILLE, Calif., Jan. 29.—All persons under 21 were barred from the courtroom today when the court opened for resumption of the sensational testimony of Arvin Ward in the Gertrude Wilson murder trial. She is charged with killing Charles Brown, Fred J. Wilson, husband of the defendant, a newspaperman, said he is confident of her composure despite Ward's testimony that he saw her in a most compromising position with Brown and that later when Brown deserted her for her younger sister she threatened to kill Brown and her sister.

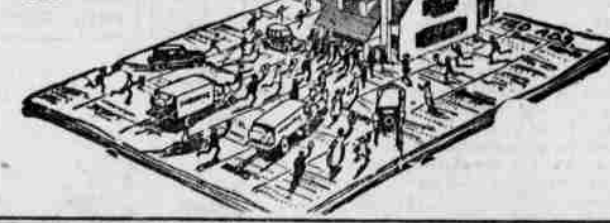
GERMAN OFFICERS AND ARMS USED ON POLES

NEW YORK, Jan. 29.—German officers, arms and ammunition are used to a large extent by the Bolsheviks in their campaign against the Polish forces, according to Major T. A. Starzynski, of Pittsburgh, chief of the medical staff of General Haller's first

Polish army, more than half of which is composed of Poles born in America. He has just returned after two years on the Polish front.

Fifty per cent of the Polish army today is in civilian clothes, according to Major Starzynski, while most of the soldiers are without shoes. This condition, he said, is shared by large numbers of school boys and girls who are fighting side by side with the soldiers in the trenches.
