INCREASE OF EXPORTS OVER IMPORTS SOARS

WASHINGTON, Jan. 29.—The excess of American exports over imports in 1919 amounted to \$4,917,000,000, a new record, according to a statement issued today by the Bureau of Foreign and Domestic Commerce, Department of Commerce. Exports for 1919 totaled \$7,922,000,000, as compared with \$5,149,000,000, while imports were valued at \$3,904,000,000 against \$3,031,000,000 in 1918.

IRISH REPUBLIC DESPERADOES STILL ELUDE UTMOST VIGILANCE OF BRITISH AUTHORITIES

DUBLIN, Jan. 29.—In spite of the utmost vigilance of the British authorities the "government of the Irish republic" is still functioning to a certain extent. Since the outbreak of the suppression of all Sinn Fein organizations and the Daily Eireann or Sinn Fein parliament the "government" has been carried on with the greatest difficulty.
