## NEWS OF THE COUNTY OFFICES AND OFFICERS

### Officials Non-Committal.

Highway Commissioners E. E. Kiddle and Highway Engineer Herbert Nunn left Pendleton yesterday afternoon without making public their decision regarding the route which the Oregon-Washington highway shall take through Weston. They together with the county commissioners, District Engineer M. O. Bennett and Roadmaster R. E. Phelps looked over the Weston situation Friday. After returning to Pendleton the state officials with Mr. Bennett drove to the west end, to go over the Old Oregon trail from Echo to the Columbia river and along the Columbia river highway toward Arlington.

### Sheep Company Sends Big Order.

The Cumnatium Sheep & Land Co. today was issued the largest consignment of state dog licenses so far received by the county clerk. There were 29 dogs in the company's herd to be licensed. There are now 800 licensed dogs in Umatilla county.

### Final Day for Filings.

Today was the final day in which applications for the foreclosure of delinquent tax certificates could be filed to be acted upon during this year. Up to press time there had been but seven applications filed.

### Four Suits Dismissed.

The four suits recently filed by the American National Bank against C. A. Brown, C. W. Brown and the two under the partnership of Brown Brothers, were ordered dismissed in Circuit court today. The actions were begun to collect on promissory notes totaling \$7450.

### Dogs Subject to Capture.

All dogs over the age of eight months, found running at large after tomorrow and unlicensed by the state, are subject to confiscation by any state officer, according to the law which governs the licensing of dogs. No announcement has been made by police officers regarding their plans to enforce the law in this county.

### LOSS OF WAR JOBS RAISES STORM OF PROTEST IN LONDON

LONDON, Jan. 31.—Working women's trade unions are raising a storm of protest against the ousting of their members from positions vacated during the war by service men. Viscountess Rhonda, organizer of the Women's Industrial League, has made this comment on their plea:

"Women should be very grateful to men for the way they have behaved toward them in their business associations during the last few years. In the business world, especially in the higher ranks, the men have stood by the women and have been prepared to judge them by the only test by which they could be judged—their efficiency."

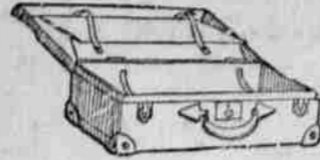

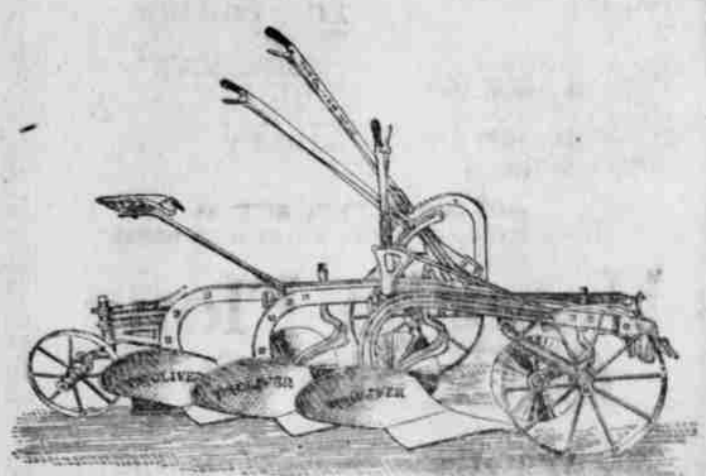
