Mill feed and the coarse grains are quoted lower in the reports from the Portland exchange today. This mill feed figure is \$43.50, a drop of 50 cents. Corn went down about \$1, to \$58 and \$58.50. Oats took a more severe slump, prices being quoted at \$45.50 and \$46 a ton.
