**APPLICATION MADE FOR SANTIEN WATER RIGHT**

SALEM, Feb. 20.—The development of 6511 horsepower at Niagara, on the North Fork of the Santian, involving the expenditure of \$50,000, is involved in the application filed with State Engineer Copper Wednesday by Charles J. Schnabel of Portland, asking for permission to appropriate 600 second feet of water at that power site on the Santian. The power so developed would be used for the development of electricity for power and lighting purposes, the application states. It is not expected that Schnabel contemplates immediate development of the project, but that he is

merely trying up the power site pending further developments against the

time when this site will be in demand for power purposes.
