NAVY WILL SEND GIANT "NANCIES" ON AIR CRUISE ACROSS PACIFIC

CHURCHES DENOUNCE ROBBERING OF EFFECTS OF DEAD CHINAMEN

WALLA WALLA, Wash., Mar. 10.—Vigorous denunciation of the actions of vandals in robbing the effects of the 11 Chinese victims of a fire here last week, at the funeral has been voted by the First Methodist church, also the First Baptist which by unanimous votes asked the city and county officials to take steps to punish the guilty.

New York, Mar. 10.—Preparations are being made by the United States navy to send two giant flying boats across the Pacific to Manila, and from there to China, according to announcement made at the national aircraft show here today.

Planes for the 3000-mile flight will be twice as large as the "Nancies" which made the trans-Atlantic flight and are now under construction. The hop-off is scheduled for next month.

AUSTRALIA PLANNED COUP IF CONSCRIPTION PLANS HAD CARRIED

LONDON, Mar. 10.—A dispatch to

the London Times from Sydney, N. S. W., quotes the labor candidate for Sydney, Mr. Mihean, as saying in a speech that if the conscription program had been carried out plans were to have been made to establish a republic in Australia.

Those responsible for the movement, he added, were relying principally on Queensland.

The correspondent says the statement has caused a sensation and that the Sydney Sun, in a leading editorial, insists that the labor party can not allow the matter to rest at this stage, maintaining that it must disavow knowledge of the alleged plot or forfeit public confidence.

SIMS CHARGES LIVES PAID PRICE OF DELAY

WASHINGTON, Mar. 10.—The war was prolonged four months by the failure of the navy department to act promptly on recommendations of allied naval authorities and himself, Admiral Sims told the senate naval affairs sub-committee which is probing the navy's war work Tuesday. He attacked the naval policy of Secretary Daniels.

Sims charged: "That the navy's failure to co-operate with the allies resulted in needless sacrifices."
