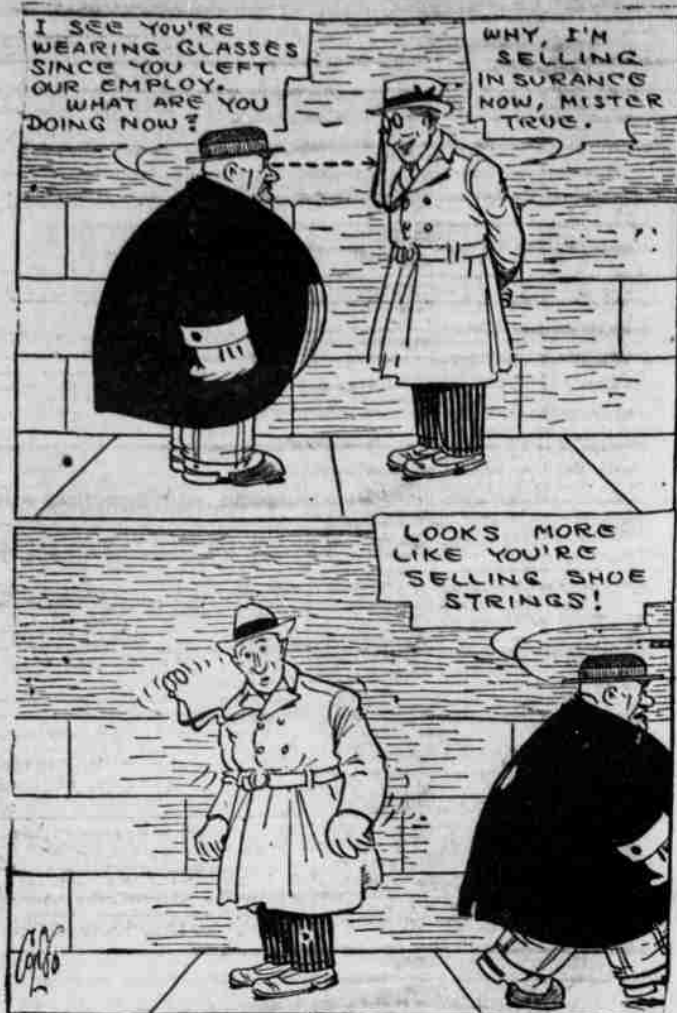

### Coffee for Month Liquidated in N. Y.

(By Associated Press.)  
NEW YORK, April 21.—Near month's liquidation was the feature in the market for coffee futures during today's early trading. The opening was 2 to 7 points below last night's closing figures, during the middle of the day with May touching 14.72c and September 14.75. Houses with European connections were sellers of May and there was scattering liquidation while trade interests bought near months against sales of later deliveries and the market rallied several points in the late trading on covering, with May closing at 14.77c and September at 14.84c. The general closed at a net decline of 6 to 16 points. April 14.55c; December 14.77c; January 14.75c; March 14.75c.

Spot coffee quiet; Rio, No. 7, 15 1-4c; Santos 4's for May, June shipment and July-September shipments at 20.75 and 19.10, respectively, American credits.

### May Delivery Corn Top Figure.

(By Associated Press.)  
CHICAGO, April 21.—Although corn displayed considerable weakness today, the market advanced to the highest level yet for May delivery. Bullish crop reports and renewed anxiety about the smallness of the amount of corn in store here had a good deal to do with the upturn. Prices closed nervous, 1-5c to 1 3-8c net higher with May 1.72 7-8 to 1.73 1-8 and July 1.66 2-8 to 1.66 1-2. Oats

gained 12c to 1c higher. In provisions the outcome varied from unchanged figures to 70c lower.

Commission houses apparently overreached themselves in pressing the bear side during the earlier trading. Until about midday, the majority of leaders held to the view that bullish factors had been discounted. Then, however, sentiment owing more or less to extremely pessimistic reports of a leading crop authority regarding domestic wheat and oats.

Oats, like corn, receded at first, but then rose to the highest prices this season. Provisions were weak.

Sheep, receipts 3500; best lambs 25 to 35c higher; top 20.55; bulk above 19.75; clipped lambs 17.50.

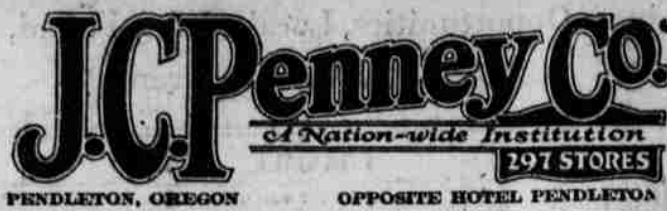
