

BLOODED HORSES FOR KENTUCKY DERBY OUT

(By Associated Press.)
 LOUISVILLE, Ky., May 4.—Thousands valued at hundreds of thousands of dollars, the names of which are on the lips of turfmen and race track followers everywhere in the United States, have begun to arrive at Churchill Downs for conditioning preliminary to the Kentucky Derby May 8. The race carrying \$250,000 in added money will be for three year olds at a mile and a quarter.

Matt J. Winn, general manager of the track, asserts that the expected \$6,000 attendance will not tax the facilities of the racing plant.

More than twenty of the more promising candidates are receiving careful attention of trainers at the Downs. Names of those horses which will attract most attention include Damask, owned by Harry Payne Whitney of New York; On Watch and Donatonna, nominated by former Congressman George W. Loft of New York; Prince Pal, Sterling, Peace Pennant, The Swimmer, Brookholt, Golden Broom, John P. Grier, Upset, Miss Jemima, Constancy, Lorraine, King Thurst, Blazes, Paul Jones, High Command, Davis Harum, Bullet Proof, By Golly and Releat.

Miss Jemima, Constancy and Lorraine are fillies. It is regarded probable that at least one will face the barrier. Only one filly however, Releat, has ever won the Derby. She ran under the Whitney colors in 1915.
