FOUNTAIN OF MOLTEN
PLAYS ABOUT VOLCANO

HILLO, Island of Hawaii, T. H., July 6.—Immense fountains of molten lava have been playing recently in the glowing lake of fire of Kilauea volcano near here.

The liquid area of the lake had shrunk a little of late owing to the formation of "spacious ramparts" and new floors, but it still occupies a considerable portion of the pit which is about 1200 by 1400 feet in its two diameters.

The lava flows on the Kau Desert, about seven miles from the main crater, which broke out during December, 1919, still are active.

JAPANESE BOY WINS
BOY SCOUT HONORS

HONOLULU, T. H., July 6.—Edward S. Matsumoto, born in Honolulu of Japanese parents, recently was promoted to the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest honor in the Boy Scouts' organization. He is the first Japanese to attain that rank in Hawaii. Matsumoto has received his education only in American schools. He has had no education in Japanese and cannot read the language of his fathers.

Rabbits Bring Down H. C. L.
HONOLULU, T. H., July 7.—Millions of rabbits are headed for Hawaii to help bring down the cost of living in the islands, according to A. Moritzson of Dunedin, New Zealand. The rabbits from the Antipodes are coming in cans—two pounds to each can—said Moritzson, who adds that they are fine eating and cost but little. New Zealand already is shipping potatoes to Hawaii and selling them here under the cost of the California article.
