FRAUDULENT SALE OF LEFT-OVER WAR STOCKS IMPLICATES 2882

PARIS, Oct. 22.—(A. P.)—Two thousand eight hundred and eighty-two government employees have been arrested, dismissed or suspended in connection with the sale of left-over American, British and French war stocks, since the appointment of Emmanuel Brousse by Premier Millerand, as Under Secretary of the State for the Liquidation of War stocks, an official not from the department says.

The American stocks proved a great attraction to employees who were imbued with the idea that liquidation began at home. Many of them are now in La Sante Prison.

AUSTRIA REPRESENTATIVE TAKES LONDON RESIDENCE

LONDON, Oct. 22.—(U. P.)—Baron Frankenstein, a former attaché of the Austrian Embassy in London, has arrived here as the first representative of the republican Austrian government after the war, and has taken up his quarters at the beautiful mansion in Belgrave Square where successive Austrian ambassadors entertained sumptuously before the war.

The requirements of the Austrian diplomatic representation are for a much more modest scale now, and as the former embassy is extremely expensive to maintain, the new minister is looking for smaller quarters. The German Legation is also anxious to find less expensive premises than the palatial mansion in Carlton House Terrace which it now occupies.

One of the things that struck Baron Frankenstein most on his arrival was, he said, that for a penny he could have quite a long bus ride which in Vienna would cost 20 times as much, at the normal rate of exchange.
