## GERMAN WORKERS JOIN IN FACTORY SEIZING

BERLIN, Nov. 12.—(By Carl D. Grant, U. P. Staff Correspondent.)—German workers seized the metal factories here today and extinguished its fires. Other factories were invaded simultaneously. Police surrounded the metal factories, planning an attack to dislodge the occupants, and other workers took possession of a gas plant on the north side of Berlin, establishing a soviet there, police reported. Seizure of the metal factory was evidently carried out by workers in emulation of Italian strikers, who captured and held plants in Italy during recent labor disturbance there. This is the

first instance of anything of the kind in Germany. The government immediately rushed measures for meeting the new menace. Police reserves and detachments of troops are held in readiness for action in event seizure of the factories should result in fighting or develop into another Spartan out-break.

Agitators are reported invading plants where there have been no difficulties, endeavoring to urge workers to join a general strike. The establishment of a soviet in the gas plant was first reported as a move of discontented workers to promote a change in government.

Sympathizers with the Russian government have been active in Germany and have urged adoption of the system here. The strength of this faction was shown at a socialist convention in Halle last month when the party was split. Establishment of a soviet was taken to mean that workers there plan to operate the business.

Although they betrayed all except their own members, they had no communication with outsiders.

## WALLA WALLA FIGHTING PARSON GIVEN MEDAL

WALLA WALLA, Wash., Nov. 12.—(A. P.)—Armistice day was observed here yesterday as a holiday by all state, county and city officials and banks and as a half holiday by all merchants. Veterans of the Civil, Spanish and World wars and local and state military bodies took part in a huge parade in the afternoon following which public exercises were held. Last night a street illumination was held. As a feature of the day Dr. Otis H. Holmes, "Walla Walla's fighting parson," was presented with a distinguished service medal for civilians by Henry Lawton post of the Spanish War Veterans.

## COUNTING 600,000 SEALS IS TASK JUST FINISHED BY CENSUS

SEATTLE, Wash., Nov. 12.—(U. P.)—Some time, when you have a hundred hours or so to spare, count up to 600,000. If you want an idea of the task just finished by G. Dallas Hanna, special agent for the United States government.

Hanna, who, each year, takes a census of the fur seals that breed on the Pribilof islands, has computed his annual job. His census, this year, is expected to show there are about 600,000 seals in the great Alaskan herd. These figures, as compared with a total of 215,733 seals in 1912, prove the manner in which government regulations are bettering sealing conditions.

## LIVESTOCK FIRM PAYS STATE ON QUITCLAIM

SALZBURG, Nov. 12.—(A. P.)—The Pacific Livestock Company on Wednesday paid to the state \$50,000 as a part of the \$125,000 for a quit claim deed to lands in litigation in Harney

and Malheur counties. The first \$25,000 was paid a year ago. The next \$50,000 is due a year from today.
