SPECIALTIES CONTINUE AS MARKET FAVORITES

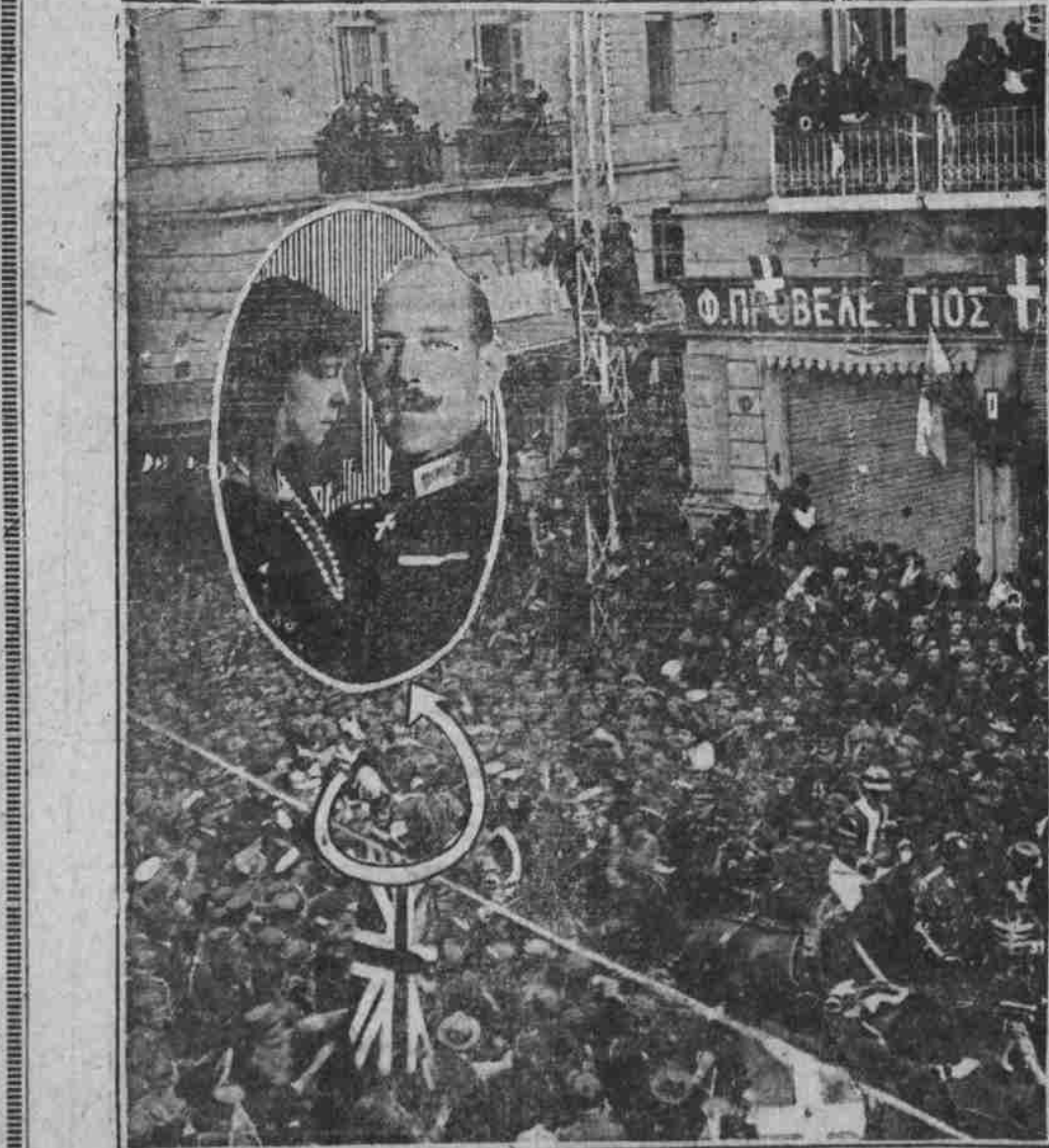

The crowds packed about Constantine's carriage and pushed carriage, horses and all to the palace.
