HAYNES CONTRACTS FOR 4000 CARS AT SHOW

The Haynes Automobile Company, Kokomo, Indiana, made contracts for 4000 Haynes cars during the period of the New York automobile show, according to a report just made public by Alton G. Selberling, vice president and general manager of the Haynes company.

Mr. Selberling and other Haynes officials were confident over the prospects for 1921, and made predictions that Haynes contracts would total more than 10,000 with the close of the Chicago automobile show the early part of February.

"This large volume of business for which we have made definite contracts so early in the season is a strong indication of a highly successful year for the Haynes company," declares Mr. Selberling. "and it looks as if the capacity of our factory will be taxed to the utmost in order to meet the demand. In my opinion, we will have on hand upwards of 10,000 orders by the time the Chicago show closes."

One significant point, however, about such contracts at this time, is the fact that the dealers everywhere are optimistic about the future, and this fact alone will help materially in making 1921 a successful year in the automobile industry."
