Notice is hereby given that at a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Pendleton held at the Council Chambers in Pendleton Oregon on February 23rd, 1921 the following Resolution was duly adopted: viz:

WHEREAS, the City Surveyor of the City of Pendleton on the 22nd day of February, 1921, under directions and by requirement of the Common Council file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Pendleton, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of the following named street in said city:

Grange street from the North Line of Court Street to the South Line of Lewis Street, together with the extension of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof with a statement of the lots, parts of lots and parcels of land to be benefited by such improvement and the percentage of the total cost of improvement, which each of such lots, parts of lots and parcels of land should pay on account of such improvement, and
