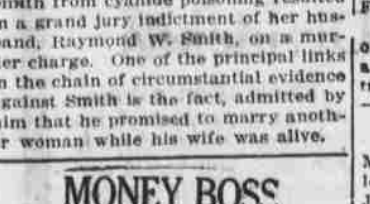
DOCTORS FIGHT HARD TO SAVE GIRLS' LIVES
