**Wheat Losses Slightly Under Pressure**

**CHICAGO**, May 11.—(A. P.)—Death of buying orders led to reactions in wheat yesterday from an advance that was ascribed largely to crop damage in the southwest. The market closed unsettled 1/2, not declining 1/2 gain with May 13 1/2 to 1 3/8, and July 1 1/2 to 1 1/2. Corn finished 1/4, 49 3/8 to 5 1/8 up, oats unchanged to 1-8 higher and provisions showing a net back of 17 to 6c.

One of the circumstances which restrained bullish sentiment regarding wheat was the tradition that May 1 has been a date favorable for spring selling and therefore a time to avoid purchase commitments. Purchases were slowest of flour demand at Minneapolis induced belief that spring wheat shipments would more largely be directed to Chicago for the present. Inactivity by exporters tended likewise to offset the strength which at first the market displayed in connection with unfavorable field advices from the southwest. Knowledge that the government report on winter wheat indicated a less generous harvest than had been looked for was to extent a stimulating factor but not of a lasting sort.

Corn and oats developed a little independent strength as a result of rains. In addition, crop reports as to oats were bullish.

Provisions were weak in line with long values.
