"Itching palms" greet the American tourist at every angle. Hotel prices, even when transferred into American money, are two or three times their former level. A room and meals on the American plan cost at least \$5 a person, where it used to cost two.

GASOLINE PRICES DROP 2 CENTS IN PENDLETON

A reduction of two cents went into effect this morning among retailers, the reduction following a drop in wholesale prices, and now Mr. Driver of the car, which in this case is the ultimate consumer, pays 34 cents instead of 36 that has prevailed for some time.

The Eastern Oregon Auto club has been fighting for a four-cent reduction, but the action of retailers favored the two-cent drop at this time.

Gasoline Drops.

PORTLAND, May 14.—(A. P.)—A two-cent a gallon reduction in the price of gasoline was announced today following a similar cut at San Francisco. This makes gasoline here 28 cents including two cents a gallon state tax.

Gas Lower, Too.

PORTLAND, May 14.—(A. P.)—Another reduction in gas rates, to be added to a reduction announced May 5, was announced today by Portland Gas and Coke company following a further cut of twenty-five cents a barrel oil price. This latest reduction combined with reductions announced in March and May 3 brings the total savings to consumers to \$150,000 annually. This newest reduction will be effective about June 15.
