TWO PRINCES TRY TO RECOVER CELEBRATED CHATEAU DE CHAMBORD

Property Was Sequestrated by French Government Dur-World War, ing Late

PARIS, May 21.--(A. P.)--Efforts two princes of the house of Bourbon-Parma to recover possession of the celebrated Chatcau de Chambord which was sequestrated by the French government during the war is one of the interesting aftermaths of the great

The Chatcau is more than 400 years old and is one of the most striking was once one of the most magnificen of these great estates and lies in the valley of the Loire close to the town of Blois and has about 15,000 acres part of which is enclosed by walls extending for 20 miles. The building i


