Not only has she campaigned in Wales, the ballwick of the Lloyd George but she has invaded opposition territory untrammelled by the hostile gestures of strong labor sections. Perhaps her greatest personal triumph was her tour of the Bedford district where a hard fight was raging between Coalition-Labor and labor candidates. She was acclaimed everywhere. The labor party sent cars and speakers in her wake, but they had a chilly reception.

EDUCATION BUILDING AND U. OF O. HIGH SCHOOL IS DEDICATED

New Building Declared to be Most Complete of its Kind on the Pacific Coast.

UNIVERSITY OF OREGON, Eugene, May 28.—The new Education Building and University of Oregon high school will be formally opened and dedicated Friday afternoon, May 27, according to an announcement by Dr. H. D. Sheldon, dean. Eight hundred special invitations have been sent to superintendents, principals and teachers in Oregon, to school boards and teaching alumni, and to patrons of the school. T. H. Cole, assistant superintendent of the Seattle schools and an authority on secondary education, will give the dedication address.

The new high school is declared to be the most complete of its kind on the Pacific coast. School superintendents and school boards of Oregon have been interested in the architecture of this one-story building, as well as in the methods of instruction used. In line with the policy of the University of Oregon to provide a highly adequate training in the various professions for which it prepares young men and women, practical work has been established in the school of education.

The university high school is in a sense an efficient laboratory affording an opportunity to prospective high school teachers for observation and study of a good quality of teaching, and for an introduction to the responsibilities of the classroom. The primary purposes of the school, in addition to the incidental giving of a wholesome type of secondary education to a number of future citizens have been three:

- 1. To demonstrate superior methods of teaching and school administration.
2. To provide opportunity for high school teachers in training to observe experienced and superior teachers at work in the classroom.
3. To furnish a laboratory for research in problems of education.
The program, which will be held in the assembly room of the University high school, with Dr. H. D. Sheldon, dean of the school of education, presiding, is as follows:
Invocation—Dean E. C. Sanderson, Eugene High University.
Music—University High School Glee Club.
Address—"The Future in Secondary Education," T. H. Cole, assistant superintendent of Seattle schools.
