Crankcase Lubrication Demonstrated A recent test showed that to prevent excessive engine wearing, crank cas-oil should be changed at least every 1500 miles, preferably every load miles. A new engine that was run 5000 miles with oil changed at proper intervals, upon being disassembled showed no signs of wear. The same engine reassembled and run 6000 miles with oil plus new oil as needed, upon inspection showed a wear of 0.015 inches. Motor truck and passenge car manufacturers, recommend that crankcase be drained every thousand miles, the engine flushed with kero sene and new oil added.






