## HINDENBURG STATUE IS NOW IN FIREWOOD

**BERLIN, June 17.**—(U. P.)—Germany's iron Hindenburg, which during the war was to epitomize the German spirit, has gone the way of the rest of wartime German things.

An advertisement in the Berlin papers announces the demise simply: "IRON HINDENBURG"

"For sale, in whole or in parts, for firewood, Apply, Dudolf Mosse, Berlin W. 8, Leipziger Strasse, 1437."

The gigantic statue—a wooden Hindenburg—was erected during the war at the end of Berlin's Avenue of Victory.

It was to be covered with nails, driven one by one by patriotic Germans, who, for the privilege of putting a bit more iron into the field marshal, were to pay a small contribution to German war charities.

The idea flattered. Long before the war ended what was at first a popular pilgrimage had turned into a religious rite. The statue remained, its woodwork rotting in huge uncovered patches and its scattered rash of nails rusting.

About a year ago, the statue, always an eyesore, was removed. No one was sufficiently interested to ask about it. Its fate was not known until Herr Hesse inserted his ad.

## DEATH CLAIMS OLDEST POLICEMAN

**PARIS, June 17.**—(U. P.)—The "oldest pol" of the great city, Maurice Scroggie, mayor of Auxerre, in Burgundy, has just died.

He was 75 years old when the mobilization call came early in August of 1914. Far beyond the military age, the rugged old mayor signed up as a volunteer, and by dint of bluffing, cajoling and threatening the army doctors, finally got himself accepted for the service.

And he didn't have any rear-sinecure, either. From 1914 until early 1919 he did the dirty work of a private, then of a corporal and sergeant, in a fighting unit, and went over the top with all the rest of the bright young men.

He had a great civic reception in 1919 at Auxerre, when covered with mud and glory, he marched into his neglected town hall, displaying his Croix de Guerre, Medaille Militaire, and Legion of Honor. Later the old "dean of the police," as the French refer to him, removed to Paris. But
