STORE LOW PRICED EGGS FOR WINTER USE, ADVICE

OREGON AGRICULTURAL COL LEGE, Corvallia, July 11.—Pack and store eggs for the winter while the price is low, suggests F. E. Pax, assist. ant professor of poultry husbandry at the Oregon Agricultural college.

"Eggs are cheap now," says Mr Fox, Next winter they will be high By packing your exgs now, you save at least half the money you would pay next winter. Packed ergs are good for cooking, but not for frying.

"If you use 9 parts of boiled water to I part of water glass your eggs will keep. The boiled water should be cooled before using. Ten quarts will fill a 5 gallon jar.

The eggs should be of in an earththen to keep dust water glass should be an inch over the eggs to allow for evaporation. Somethe solution thickens but this donen't mean that the eggs will spoil. Water should not be poured in to make the solution thin,"


