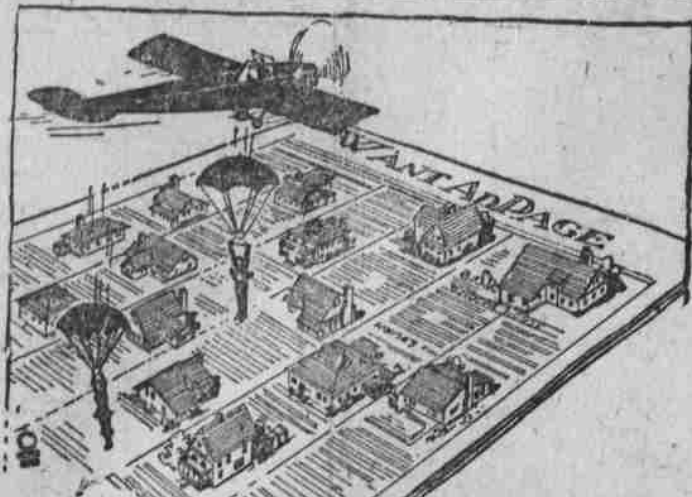

EXCHANGE RATES KEEP MANY TOURISTS FROM VISITING SWITZERLAND

BERNEVA, Switzerland, July 23.—(A. P.)—Switzerland has reached the acute stage of economic stringency resulting from a too favorable rate of exchange. The tourist season, upon which she depends for such a great extent, opened with little prospect of an improvement in the situation. Tourists who usually visit Switzerland during the summer, are going to France where Swiss money counts for twice its value at home, or in Italy, where it counts five times the normal value. The crisis shows not only in the absence of tourist trade but in industrial stagnation, a good many workers being already out of employment.

Millions of pounds of picric acid accumulated for war purposes and made useless to the War Department by the armistice, will be distributed to farmers for agricultural purposes. This acid is a highly crystalline powder, lemon colored, and eighteen per cent stronger than forty per cent nitro-sulphuric dynamite. It is never used in bulk but in paraffined paper cartridges.
