Get Marriage License
Ray Alexander, farmer and Hulda Helesne Johnson, teacher, have been granted a license to wed.

September 17 is to be observed by the schools in Umatilla county as Constitution Day, announcement today from the office of the county superintendent of school indicates.

On Account and Note
The sum of \$420 is sought by E. C. Cotter who through Peterson, Bishop and Clark has brought suit against P. Ben Jory. The amount is said to be past due on a note and on account.

Sues On Account
Notes alleged to be past due are the basis of a suit that has been brought by Pearl Myrick as guardian for Blanche Alverda Emery and Dale Eugene Emery against Harry Myrick.

The amount of \$736.75 is sought on two causes of action. Keator and Randall represent the plaintiff.

Seeks Divorce
Frank Myrick is made defendant in a suit for divorce that has been filed in circuit court by Raley, Raley and Steiner and H. J. Warner for Irene Myrick. According to the complaint the couple married in 1906 at Cove, Oregon, and there are two children. Cruel and inhuman treatment is the basis of the complaint. Myrick was recently fined in city court for striking a man who was with his wife on the street. In the complaint several other instances are cited.

Diamonds Cause Trouble
Two diamonds, weighing one carat and three-fourths carats respectively, and valued at \$1,000 by the owner are the bone of contention in a suit that has been filed in circuit court by Keator and Randall in behalf of Flora Queener. Jose Pedro is the defendant, and it is said, that the plaintiff made a loan of the stones to the defendant and that when a demand was made for their return this was refused. A judgment for possession of the diamonds and a judgment for \$1,000 is sought.

MARRIED LIFE IN THIS COUNTY VERY UNCERTAIN STATISTICS SET FORTH

Let the man and maid who wed in Umatilla county take great care, because separation and divorce are about as likely to be their lot as happily wedded life. This at least is the state of affairs disclosed by an investigation made by Deputy Clerk Cyril Probstel who was requested by Prof. George L. Koehn of Reed College, Portland, to furnish data on marriage and divorce.

The tables show that beginning with 1917 the number of marriages has been as follows: 234, 189, 232 and 244. Up until September 1 the record for 1921 is 135.

For the same period, divorces have been as follows:

Up until Sept. 1, 1921, 36 divorces have been granted and 26 have been dismissed or are pending.
