LONDON, Sept. 8.—(U. P.)—Im-pressive simplicity marked the memorial services for the American and Brit-ish dead from the ZR-2 disaster in Westminister Abbey, King George and Queen Mary attended the services. Chaplain Viener, of the Royal Air forces referred to the dead as: "martyrs to science." The Cruiser Dauntiess is expected to arrive in the United States with the American bodies shortly, when memorial services will be held on Brooklyn piers Sep-tember 17. High naval officers will participate in the services.




