PINEAPPLE CROP NOT SO BIG; SHORTAGE LOOMS

HONOLULU, Sept. 17.—(I. N. S.)—A pack of 5,884,000 cases of canned Hawaiian pineapples for the 1931 season in the advance estimate given out by officials of the Pineapple Packers' Association, in Honolulu. Last year's pack ran over 8,000,000 cases, but poor growing conditions, combined with in- or troubles, is cutting down the pack for the current year.

As a result of the shortage as compared with last year, while an extensive advertising campaign is being conducted on the mainland, a scarcity of "pines" is apt to be felt on the market before the 1932 crop is in cans, local pineapple men predict.
