### Forest Service at Portland, Oregon.

The Pacific Northwest experiment station would be one of the 13 ultimately needed to meet a timber situation already growing so critical that the United States may in the future face the necessity of dependence upon a foreign supply, with drastic allowances as to amount and resultant high prices.

"With the exception of one census year," says the report, "the State of Washington has stood first in lumber production since 1905. Oregon, tenth in 1907, had reached third place in 1918. No other state can compare in total stand with Oregon, with its total of nearly 500,000,000,000 feet, although Washington is hardly a bad second with more than 330,000,000,000 feet. Lumber production in the Pacific Northwest has been one of the greatest industries since early days; in fact, the prosperity of these States is measured in terms of the prosperity of the lumber industry."

"The Alaskan Panhandle with its water power, its numerous mill sites on protected water channels, and its 73,000,000,000 feet of excellent pulp timber, now stands at the threshold of a pulp and paper industry which in a comparatively few years should rival that of Scandinavia. This region can be made to supply in perpetuity at least one-fourth of the present total pulp requirements of the United States or one-half of our present news-print requirements. opportunity to develop an industry which will go far toward making us independent of Canada and other foreign supplies, but as yet no work has been done to develop methods of cutting that will assure a permanent timber growth.

"The lines of work for the Pacific Northwest and Alaska with respect to fire protection, three planting, silviculture and timber management must parallel under different conditions and with different species those already outlined for other forest regions of the United States."

Here are some of the things the forest experiment stations should do, the department says:  
"Determine what kind of trees can and should be grown.  
"Find out how to plant.  
"Determine best methods of cutting and slash disposal.  
"Answer many questions concerning forest management.  
"Ascertain growth and yields.  
"Establish the basis for improved methods of fire protection.  
"Cooperate in forest management problems closely related to wood utilization.  
"Furnish the scientific basis for forestry."

### FOREST EXPERIMENT STATION IMPORTANT

To maintain the vast forests of the Pacific Northwest, Oregon and Alaska, and study and apply methods which will insure continued forest growth and prevent the disastrous lumbering practices followed in eastern and western states, the Pacific Northwest forest experiment station, now very inadequately manned, should gradually be enlarged, declares the Forest Service, United States Department of Agriculture, in a circular just off the press.
