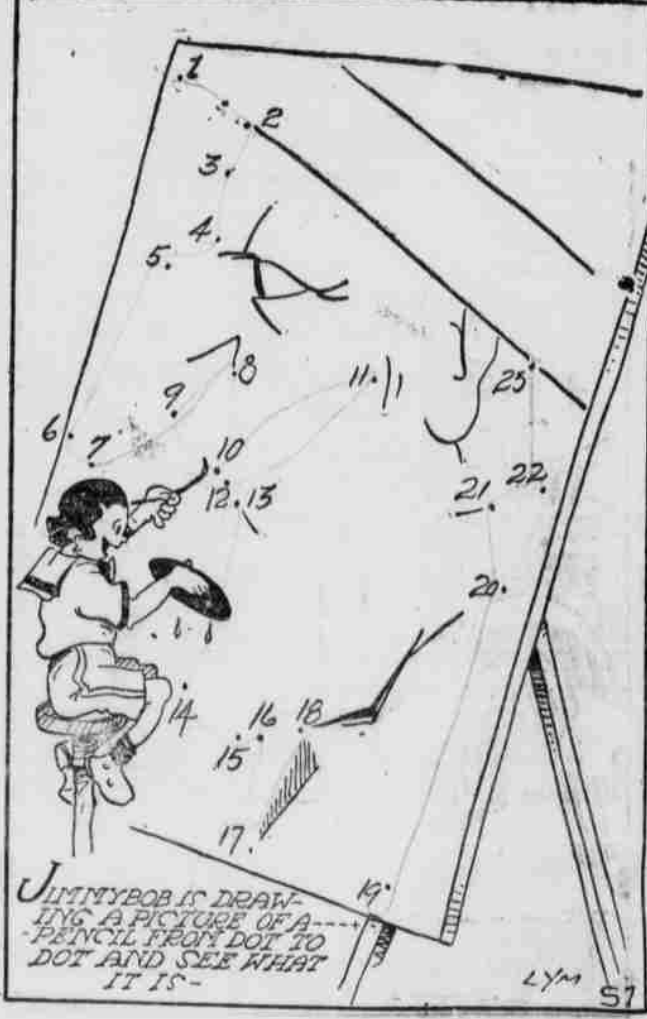


Going to the Root.

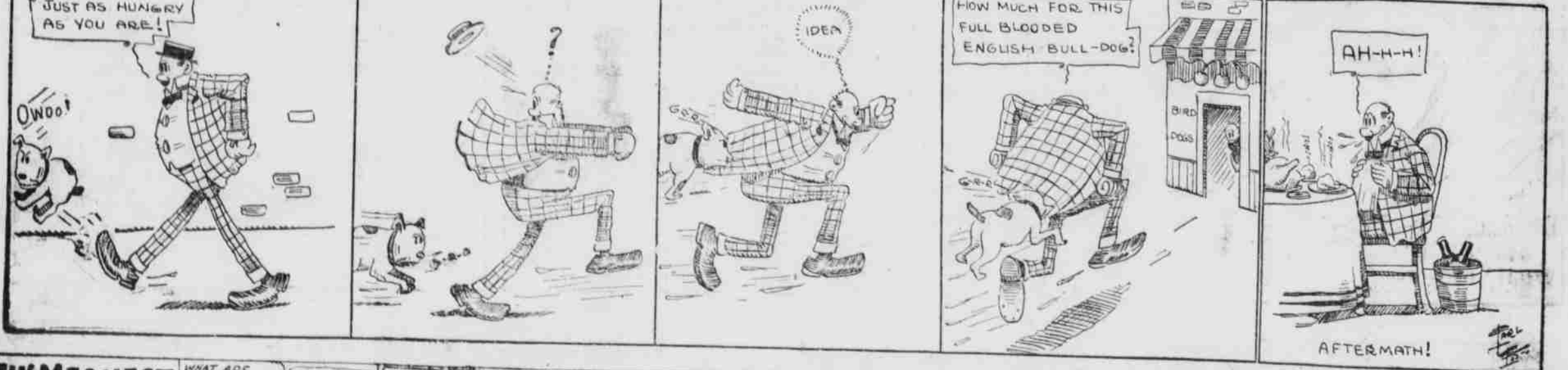
