## TOO MANY VENTUREMEN CLOG FLORIDA COURT

BRISTOL, Fla. Nov. 21.—(I. N. S.)—Two names too many in the sealed jury box of Liberty County, placed there by the Board of County Commissioners, had the effect of setting an indictment in the case of S. I. Revell, former County Clerk, quashed, and the undoing of all work that the Grand Jury, which had been drawn from the box, had accomplished. Before this discovery was made several cases in civil actions had been disposed of. It is believed that all these will suffer likewise and all court work be undone.

The development came when attorneys for Revell presented a motion setting forth the plea that the jury commissioners had violated the law by placing more names in the box than allowed by law. It was asserted that the law stipulated that 250 names should be placed in the box and sealed, but on the names being counted it was found that 252 had been placed therein. Judge Love ruled that the point was a good one and quashed the affidavits and indictments against the clerk, who was accused of embezzling state funds. The judge also ordered court to stand adjourned until a new venire could be summoned.

## SWISS COLONIES TO BE ESTABLISHED IN CANADA

WINNIPEG, Man., Nov. 21.—(I. N. S.)—Swiss colonies are to be established in Canada. Mountain-loving folk of the little republic are to become prairie farmers. The first group will arrive with the establishment of a silk plant in Toronto by Swiss capital. This industry will spread to other points and serve as a means of ready employment for the immigrants most of whom will later take up farming.

There has never been a tide of immigration from Switzerland to the American continent. Contentment was a predominant characteristic before the wave of post-war unrest and depression. Now large numbers of the industrious folks are turning hopeful faces toward Canada. The influx is expected to be large.

Experience has shown that the Swiss are most desirable immigrants. Their natural industry makes them builders. Their quick adoption of western manners makes assimilation easy.

Of Canada's total population the Swiss comprise less than 10 per cent. Practically all are prosperous farmers. The forefathers of many were pioneers. The first Swiss settlers came over just a hundred years ago.

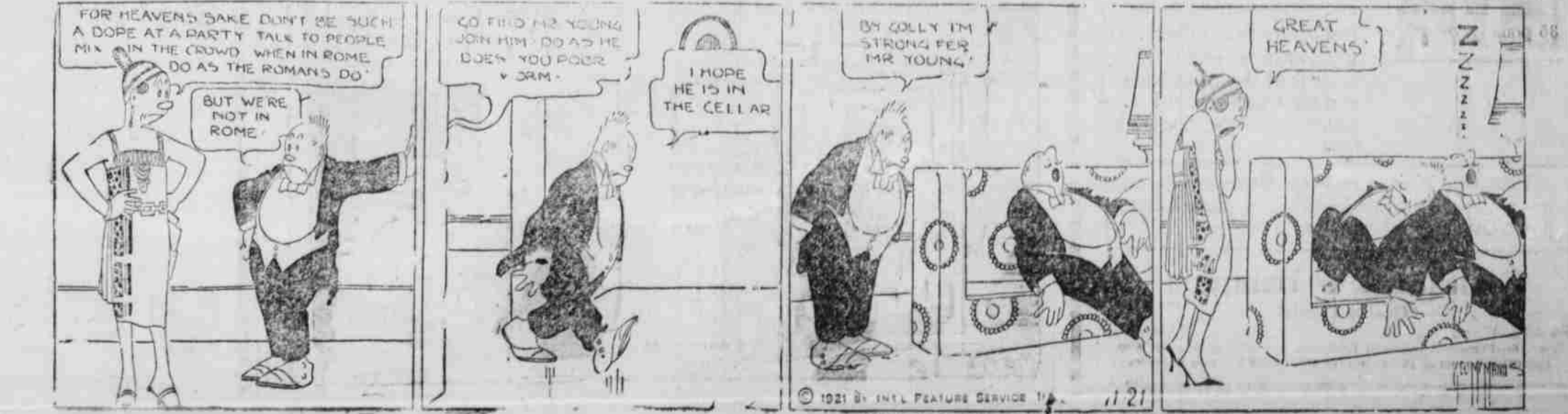
