Be It Resolved, that the Oregon Irrigation Congress in its next annual session assembled, ask the state to be heard to delay the calling of bonds for irrigation districts until a test case can be brought on until the next regular session of the legislature, that an opportunity be had to clear up this point of law either by an opinion of the court or through amendment of the law.

McNary-Smith bill can undoubtedly be made without placing an excessive burden upon the taxpayers, due to the fact that large revenues will be accruing to the federal government, as shown by the annual report of the department of the interior, and due also to the fact that the advances made under the McNary-Smith bill constitute a revolving fund which is finally repaid to the federal government in full, and

Whereas, The McNary-Smith bill provides that preference be given both in employment and priority of filing on reclaimed lands, to honorably discharged soldiers and sailors who served during the world war, therefore,

Be It Resolved, by the Oregon Irrigation Congress, in eleventh annual convention assembled, that we heartily endorse the McNary-Smith reclamation bill and recommend that this bill be passed at the present session of congress, and

Be It Further Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the committee on irrigation and reclamation, of which Charles L. McNary is chairman, and a copy to each senator and representative in congress from Oregon.

Whereas, the land of the present Umatilla experiment station is not representative or adequate, there is good prospect of the early completion of the McKay reservoir which will provide water for the fifth unit of the Umatilla project and other lands, and

Whereas, there is projected irrigation, developed and improved land in Umatilla basin of about half a million acres of light, sandy character, requiring special methods of management and an experiment station is now maintained by the state and the United States department of agriculture,

Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the proper state and government officials be and are hereby urged to take necessary steps to provide for reclamation of 200 acres of public land situated just south of the Oregon Trail and west of the fee, equal between Stanfield and Heermiston and a water right for same as a new experiment farm, it having been found more suitable and representative, and

Further, that at the proper time arrangements be made to capitalize the land and improvements of the Umatilla Branch Experiment Station for providing funds with which to purchase buildings and other improvements on the proposed new Umatilla branch experiment station.

Whereas, the attorney general of the state having given an opinion that the bonding of school funds upon bonds in bonded irrigation districts is contrary to law, holding that the irrigation bonds are a first lien, and

Whereas, various attorneys differ from this opinion, holding that irrigation and drainage bonds are a first lien and in the same class as school and road bonds, and

Whereas, the state bar board, acting upon the opinion of the attorney general is withdrawing school funds
