PROF. FISHER TO STUDY EUROPEAN ECONOMICS

LONDON, Jan. 7.—(U. S. S.)—Professor Irving Fisher, of Yale University, has arrived in London to study European economic questions specially relating to the stability of the exchange.
 He thinks that England is the only country that can recover the old par value, but questions whether it will be worth the cost to remove the present embargo and constitute a free gold market.
