**First Meet Scheduled**

**EAST LANSING, Mich., April 21.**—(A. P.)—For the first time in the history of the college, Michigan Argos will compete in a dual meet with a Western conference track team, when they meet Ohio State here May 29.

Track and field coaches are not predicting that they will win over Ohio State, but regardless of the outcome they believe the Argos will make a creditable showing in their first dual tryout in fast company.

The dual meet with Ohio State was taken on by college athletic authorities as a substitute for the long trip which entrance is the coldest at Pittsburgh would necessitate.

### SWIMMING POPULAR DOWN IN ARGENTINE

**BUENOS AIRES, (By Mail to the United Press).**—Argentina is setting new world swimming records for distance and endurance in the water, and the past month has witnessed performance of remarkable feats in the Rio de la Plata.

Far surpassing the achievement of Tiraboschi, who established a precedent by crossing the 30 mile width of the stream in 1920, is that of an Argentine amateur swimmer, "Senior Romeo Machiel, present holder of the world's record. The latter attained this distinction by crossing from Colonia to Punta Lara, a distance of 50 kilometers, and 299 metres in 24 hours, 23 minutes and 48 seconds. Lieutenant Juan Luis Garamendy, of the Argentine army, is shortly to attempt to outdo this.

Marcel's crossing of the river made on March 13. The swimmer's voracious appetite nearly cost him his laurels, for food administered to him

while he was in the water was consumed in such quantities that cramps resulted. Eighteen hours after entering the water, he showed the stuff he is made of by treading water and mimicking the playing of a guitar while in a clear loud voice he sang a song in the Guarany Indian tongue.

Only about a week previous Miss Lillian G. Harrison, aged 17, had capped what was then thought to be the climax of this year's aquatic season by remaining 10 hours and one minute in the river Platt while she made the passage from San Isidro, a suburb on the south bank, to the New Basin, in the port of Buenos Aires, triumphing over all existing records by slightly over three hours. Miss Harrison used the breast stroke, the entire distance, keeping an even rate of 27 to the minute.

**Prospects Not Bright**

**SEATTLE, Wash., April 21.**—(A. P.)—With two letter men, Bill Taylor and Stewart Barker, on the courts, tryouts for the University of Washington tennis team will be under way shortly. According to Coach Jimmy Arbutnot, prospects for the season are anything but bright.

Marshall Allen, Premier of last year's racquet men, did not enter school this year, and Don Waller, crack left hander, is ineligible. Arthur Bailey, Hamilton Olin and Chester Vincent are members of last year's "fresh" squad who will try for places on this year's varsity.

Captain Arthur F. Doran, of the 76th artillery, Camp Lewis, has been detailed as instructor to field artillery, Washington National Guard, with headquarters at Walla Walla.
