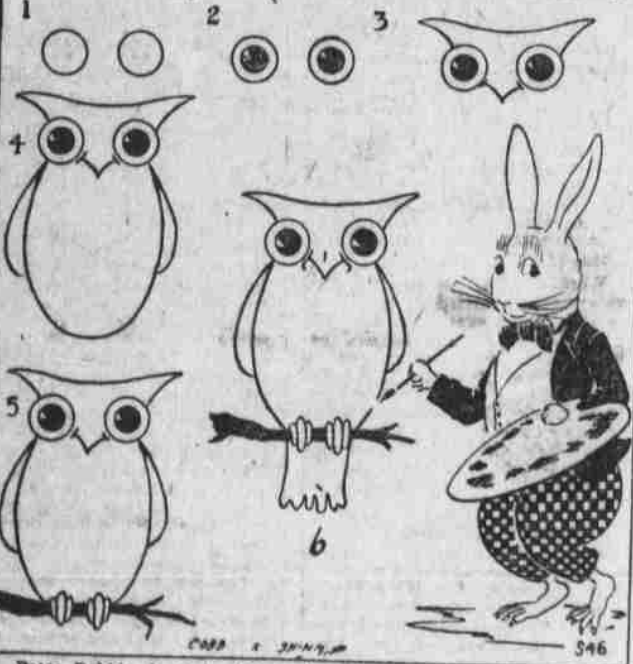

NAVY YOU CAN DRAW THE WISE OWL THAT IS A VERY HANDSOME FOWL



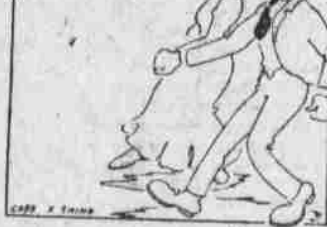

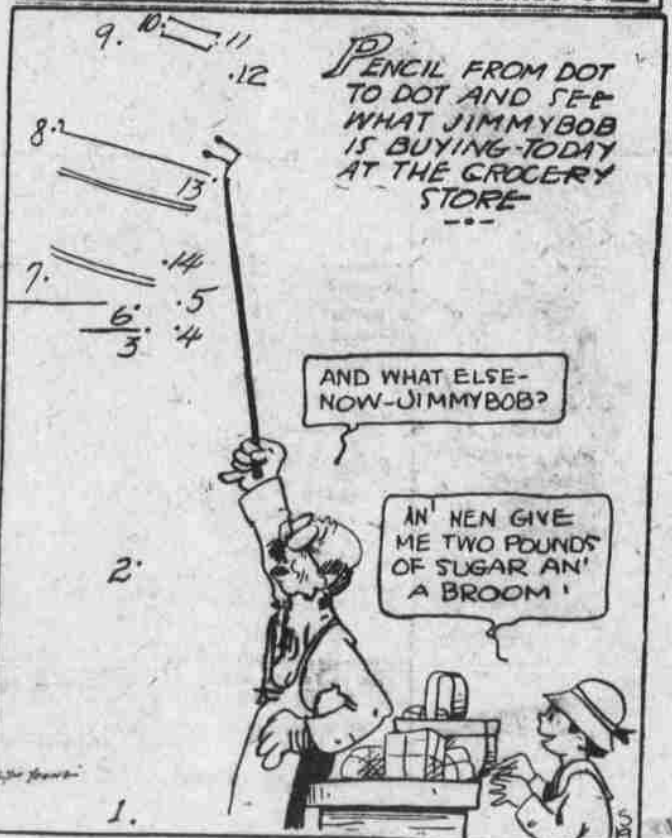


All In for the Last Show—
