ENGLAND TESTS ALL-METALLIC AEROPLANE

LONDON, Sept. 13.—The Air Minis-try is now experimenting with all-metal troop-carrying aeroplanes. metal troop-carrying aeroplanes. These form the most important feature of the important all-metal trials now going on. They are designed for the transport of twenty-five fully equipped soldiers, with a machine gun and Phone 296-J. an adequate supply of ammunition.

Two of these machines are now be ing biult at Weybridge. They have not yet been submitted to a complete series of experiments, and until this is done no large orders for their manufacture will be placed.

These machines are destined, primarily, for operation in tropical parts of the British Empire, where large acress have to be policed and where the chief danger lies in the sudden uprising of some isolated tribe. The first of the craft will be tried in Mesopotamia, where the Royal Air Force is to be given complete command and where is will have, for the first time, its own infantry and cavalry.
