ENGLAND TESTS ALL-METALLIC AEROPLANE

LONDON, Sept. 13.—The Air Ministry is now experimenting with all-metal troop-carrying aeroplanes. These form the most important feature of the important all-metal trials now going on. They are designed for the transport of twenty-five fully equipped soldiers, with a machine gun and an adequate supply of ammunition.

Two of these machines are now being built at Weybridge. They have not yet been submitted to a complete series of experiments, and until this is done no large orders for their manufacture will be placed.

These machines are destined, primarily, for operation in tropical parts of the British Empire, where large areas have to be policed and where the chief danger lies in the sudden uprising of some isolated tribe. The first of the craft will be tried in Mesopotamia, where the Royal Air Force is to be given complete command and where it will have, for the first time, its own infantry and cavalry.

Troop-carriers, if successful, will do away with the necessity of forced marches, to some outpost, often through very hot and arid country, where trouble is being caused or threatened by natives. It will thus be possible to deal with an outbreak in its early stages, as a force sufficient to quell an ordinary rising could be hurried to the spot, even if several
