Invitation Tips

- Save-the-date cards are usually sent to guests 6 to 9 months in advance of the wedding.
- Mail the invitation 6 to 8 weeks before the wedding.
- Do not include registry information on the invitation.
- Check with your reception site or caterer to see if they provide number cards to identify reception tables.
- Include response cards and preaddressed envelopes.
- Add a map/directions card if your reception is in a different location from the ceremony
- Square and odd shaped envelopes cost more to mail than standard sizes.
- Do not use abbreviations when addressing your invitations, unless it is a person's title.
- Mail formal wedding announcements the day of the wedding or the day after. Formal announcements are typically sent to those not invited to the wedding.
