Pesticides, flame retardants may lead to lamprey decline

PORTLAND (AP) — Researchers say high levels of pesticides, flame retardants, and mercury in Pacific lampreys may be contributing to their overall decline in the Columbia River Basin.

The findings come from a study by the U.S. Geological Survey and the Columbia River Inter-Tribal Fish Commission. The research found that concentrations of some flame retardants and pesticides were several hundred times higher in larval and juvenile lamprey tissues than in the surrounding sediments.

Lamprey numbers have declined dramatically in the Columbia Basin over the past 30 years.

Pacific lampreys are integral to ecosystem health. They provide food to tribal communities and offer an

alternate food source to sea lions, terns, and other predators that would otherwise be munching on threatened salmon.

Experts say the findings highlight the urgency to clean up the Columbia.

Brown to deliver 'state of the state' address Friday

SALEM — Governor Kate Brown announced Thursday she will deliver her first state of the state address Friday, two months to the day after she took over the state's top job from John Kitzhaber.

Brown will deliver the speech to a sold-out audience as part of Portland City Club's weekly forum at Sentinel Hall. It will be broadcast on OPB and the text of the speech will be made available on the governor's website as soon as it begins, according to her office.

meaningful opportunities for all Oregonians who are working hard to make a better life for their families," Brown said in a statement Thursday. "It's important, as our economic picture continues to brighten, that all Oregonians can thrive, no matter who they are or what part of the state they live in. Although there is much still to be done, we are back on track, working together, and moving forward."

Rex Fuller named president of Western Oregon University

Fuller arrives in Monmouth from Eastern Washington University, where has had been provost and vice president for academic affairs since 2011.
