Dorothy Geraldine Cereghino, 89, of Pendleton, Oregon, died April 16, 2015, in Pendleton after a brief hospitalization.

She was born November 23, 1925, in Angus, Minnesota, the eldest daughter of Thomas and Emma (Helm) Taus. Dorothy grew up in rural Minnesota and graduated from Warren High School in 1942. She lived in Grand Forks, North Dakota; Salt Lake City, Utah; McMinnville, Oregon; Portland, Oregon; and Pendleton, Oregon. She also lived in the United Kingdom and Okinawa during her husband's tours of military duty.

Dorothy married Aldo H. Cereghino June 3, 1946. They had three children. He died April 6, 2004. She and Al moved to Pendleton in the fall of 1968 when she accepted a teaching position at Pendleton High School. She taught business education and then English from 1968-1985. Dorothy also held numerous positions

with the federal government prior to and after teaching.

In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by her parents and her older brother, Thomas Earl Taus. She is survived by her sisters, Marion Gee and Mildred Yarde and brother Robert Taus; children Adele Koot (John), Nancy Wilson (Dennis) and Mark Cereghino; grandchildren Gretchen Korver (Kirk), Leah Wilson (Shawn Witherup), Keith Wilson (Sarah Cole) and Jiny Cereghino; and great-grandchildren Henry Korver and Madeleine Korver. She is also survived by numerous cousins, nieces and nephews.
